The following explains the various features implemented on our site to aid accessibility:

Headings and Menus

HTML heading tags (H1 and H2) are used in the correct way to convey document structure. Main and sub navigation menus are marked up as HTML lists.

Images

All images have descriptive alt tag attributes. If you come across any that have been missed, then please let us know.

Text

You can change the size of the text by changing your browser settings to your own preference. This will cause the website to display differently as text has been set to a specific size for optimal viewing within each page design.

Colours

The various colour combinations on the site have been carefully chosen to ensure they contrast significantly and are clear to read. Our site uses a design where overriding these colours is not possible.

Stylesheets

The site utilises cascading style sheets for visual layout. If your browser or device does not support stylesheets, structured semantic mark-up ensures that the content is readable.

Forms

Form fields are presented in a logical tab sequence and have 'label' and 'id' attributes for ease of use.

JavaScript

The use of JavaScript has been kept to a minimum. Where it is used, pages are still accessible when JavaScript is turned off.
